THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT YOUR WORK HOURS

Maximum Hours Allowed

ELM 432.32

Except as designated in labor agreements for bargaining unit employees or in emergency situations as determined by the postmaster general (or designee)

Employees may not be required to work more than 12 hours in 1 service day. In addition, the total hours of daily service, including scheduled workhours, overtime, and mealtime, may not be extended over a period longer than 12 consecutive hours.

Note: The above applies to full-time, part-time and PSE employees. The exception in our labor agreement is for full-time regulars on the Overtime Desired List.

Mealtime

ELM 432.33

Except in emergency situations or where service conditions preclude compliance, no employee may be required to work more than 6 continuous hours without a meal or rest period of at least 1/2 hour.

Note: The above applies to all employees represented by the APWU. It is incumbent of you to know your right's and request to see a steward if you are required to work more than 6 continuous hours without a lunch/rest break.

Breaks

The break policy in the San Antonio Post Office Installation is two (2) fifteen (15) minute breaks on an eight (8) hour tour. Working more than 9 hours in a service day shall include a 3rd break.

Note: Local Level Agreement of the Parties and Past Practice.
The Break Policy applies to all employees represented by the APWU in the San Antonio Post Office Installation.
