## **MVS Payouts from National Award held in abeyance since 2008**

The SAAAL has won a victory through the Grievance Process whereby the Postal Service was found in violation of the contract in 2008 when they used Casual Employees on overtime before maximizing the OTDL.

CONGRATULATIONS to Barry Payne, then 2008 Assistant MVS Director of record filing multiple grievances which were held in abeyance for pending the outcome of a National Grievance.

As a result, \$5,000 was divided to the aggrieved MVS APWU Members

**CONTRACT ENFORCEMENT**

“Article 8, Section 5.H of the 2006 USPS/APWU National Agreement, which requires full-time employees on the overtime desired list (OTDL) to be given priority scheduling for overtime work over casual employees includes priority scheduling for penalty overtime prior to casuals doing overtime work.”

Even though we no longer have a Casual work force the grievance demonstrates that the grievance process works even when delayed by management.
