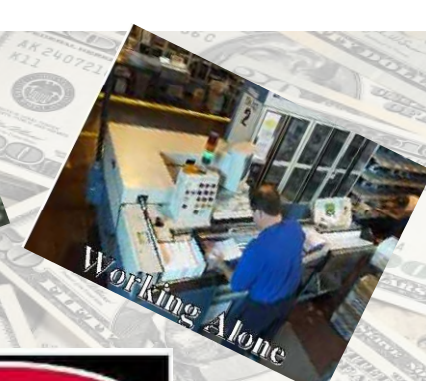
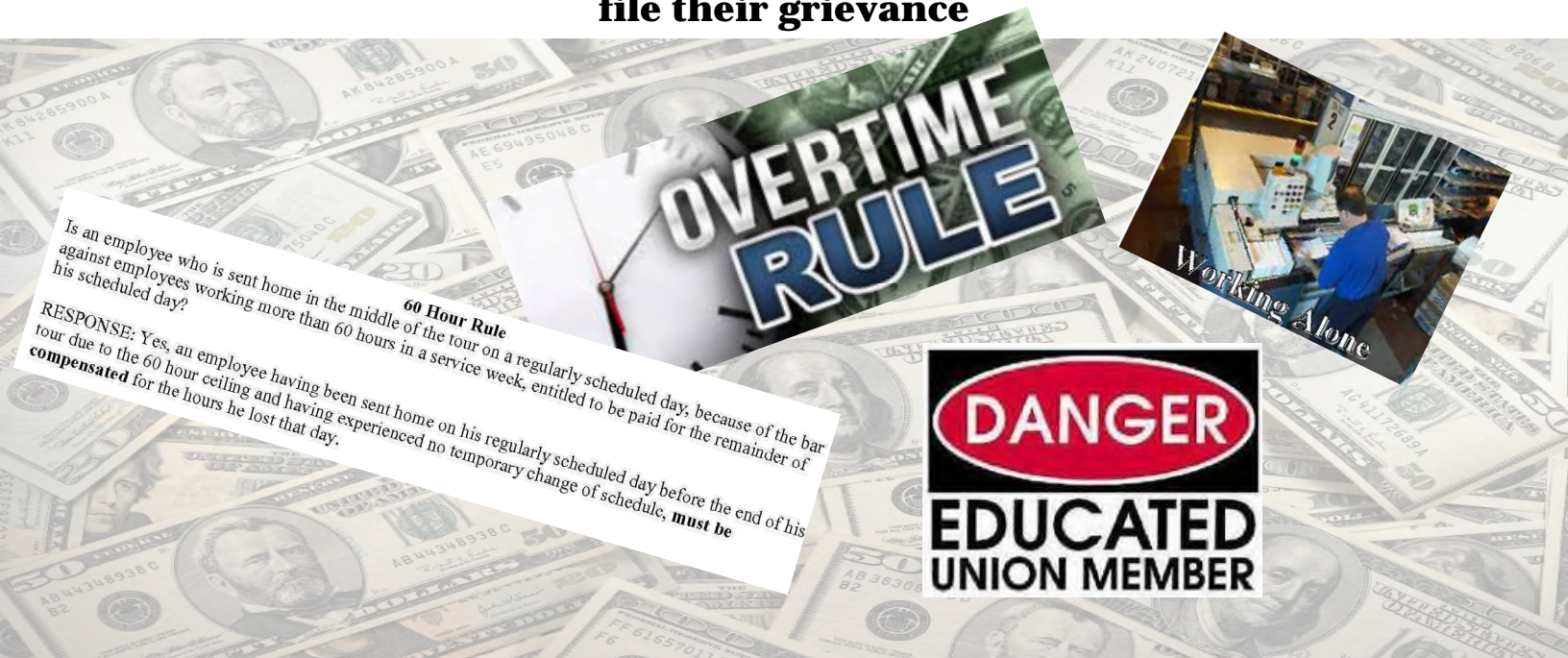

APWU members receiving \$\$\$ for Contract Violations

APWU Plant Stewards have been filing and resolving grievances for Contract violations resulting in over \$4,000 in payments. Violations include working alone on the DBCS, working over 60 hours in a service week, and multiple overtime rules violations.

These grievances were filed by members that want to protect their rights and were willing to report the violations so the Steward could file their grievance



Is an employee who is sent home in the middle of the tour on a regularly scheduled day, because of the bar against employees working more than 60 hours in a service week, entitled to be paid for the remainder of his scheduled day?
60 Hour Rule
RESPONSE: Yes, an employee having been sent home on his regularly scheduled day before the end of his tour due to the 60 hour ceiling and having experienced no temporary change of schedule, **must be compensated** for the hours he lost that day.
