San Antonio Early Voting Begins May 30th



Early voting in person begins on Tuesday, May 30th and goes through Tuesday, June 6th. We hope that as many of our registered union members will be able to vote early (those over 65 or disabled can vote by mail, as well as those at school or on jobs out of town -- call 335-VOTE for more info on mail voting.)

Those who voted in the first election must come back out and vote a second time. Those who did not vote can participate in this election. All must bring the proper credentials to vote.

Bob Comeaux will be receiving the list of the early voters who voted the prior day. You can then make a note of who has voted, and call or contact those who have not voted to boost our turnout for our endorsed candidates.

Mayor -- Ron Nirenberg
