It is with a heavy heart that we notify you of the passing of **Dolores Carol Allen Nieto Perez McIntosh** **1935 - 2017**



December 25, 1935 Dolores Carol Allen Nieto Perez McIntosh was born to Jack Allen and Hedwig Raudies on December 25th, 1935 in Jamaica Long Island, New York. She went to live with her adoptive parents her uncle Angel and aunt Michaela Nieto in San Antonio at five years old. She attended Highland Park Elementary and graduated from Saint Gerard's High School in 1953.

She met her husband of forty-nine years, Rudy Perez, Jr. while on a blind date to see the movie, The Bad Seed. They were married on May 25th, 1957 at Saint Gerard's Catholic Church. Dolores and Rudy had four children, Michael, Carole, William, and Roseanna. The family lived in San Antonio, Arlington, and finally Lake Buchanan

after his retirement from the American Postal Workers Union. Upon Rudy's death, Dolores returned to San Antonio to be near her daughters.

The San Antonio Alamo Area Local business/main office is named after Rudy Perez Jr. as he is the only SAAAL member to be elected to a National Office with the American Postal Workers Union. He was elected as a National Business Agent for the Clerk Craft. We were pleased to see her just recently at the SAAAL 100 Year Anniversary Celebration.

Dolores was a member of the Mayor's Commission on the status of women. Dolores was preceded in death by her first husband, Rudy Perez Jr. Survivors include her children: Martin Michael Perez, Carole Elizabeth Blair, William Anthony Perez, and Roseanna Marie Perez; grandson Graeham Newton Blair; and son-in-law Dr. Tim Martindell, god-child Maggie Hayes.
